Highway works at Wellesley

As you will be aware we have been carrying out works to upgrade the junction of Hospital Hill, Pennefathers Road and Queens Avenue north of Aldershot town centre. These works are due to be completed in the New Year and will improve access between Aldershot town centre and Wellesley.

Next year we plan to widen the footpaths along Hospital Hill down towards the town and improve the pedestrian crossings at the Wellington Avenue junction.



Development update...

Our Maida zone at Wellesley is nearly complete and home to 215 families.

Corunna

As you will have seen work is now well underway on the first two phases of our second zone, Corunna, on the opposite side of Queens Avenue. The 277 new homes are being delivered by Bellway and Ashberry Homes. The family homes are on sale now and range from one-bedroom apartments to 5-bedroom houses. We have also recently completed the land sale for phases 3 and 4 – Barratt David Wilson will be delivering over 400 new homes on land heading west towards the Farnborough Road.

Gunhill

Work is now progressing on our Gunhill Zone located between Gun Hill and Middle Hill. Our contractor, Careys plc is creating 107 private rental homes ranging from one bedroom apartments to four-bedroom houses which will be managed by Grainger plc. The first homes are due to be ready for occupation in Autumn 2018. We have


recently closed the pedestrian footpath between Gun Hill and Middle Hill while Careys undertake works in the area. The footpath is due to be closed for up to 12 months and we have been working with the nearby Talavera Schools to ensure that any disruption is minimal and a diversion route is in place. McGrigor

Planning permission has now been granted for our McGrigor zone. Opposite the Cambridge Military Hospital, we expect to start infrastructure works for the zone Spring next. The area will be home to 116 family homes and will see the conversion of the beautiful McGrigor Barrack buildings.

Cambridge Primary School Update

Located on the crossroads of Queens Avenue and Alisons Road, Osbourne's are delivering the £10.6m Cambridge Primary School. The school will be open in September 2018 and will be managed by local provider Engage, Enrich and Excel Academies. The school will initially open one Reception class. The school will eventually provide 420 primary school places for children aged between 4-11 years old. Admissions to the school are now open and will close at the end of January.
